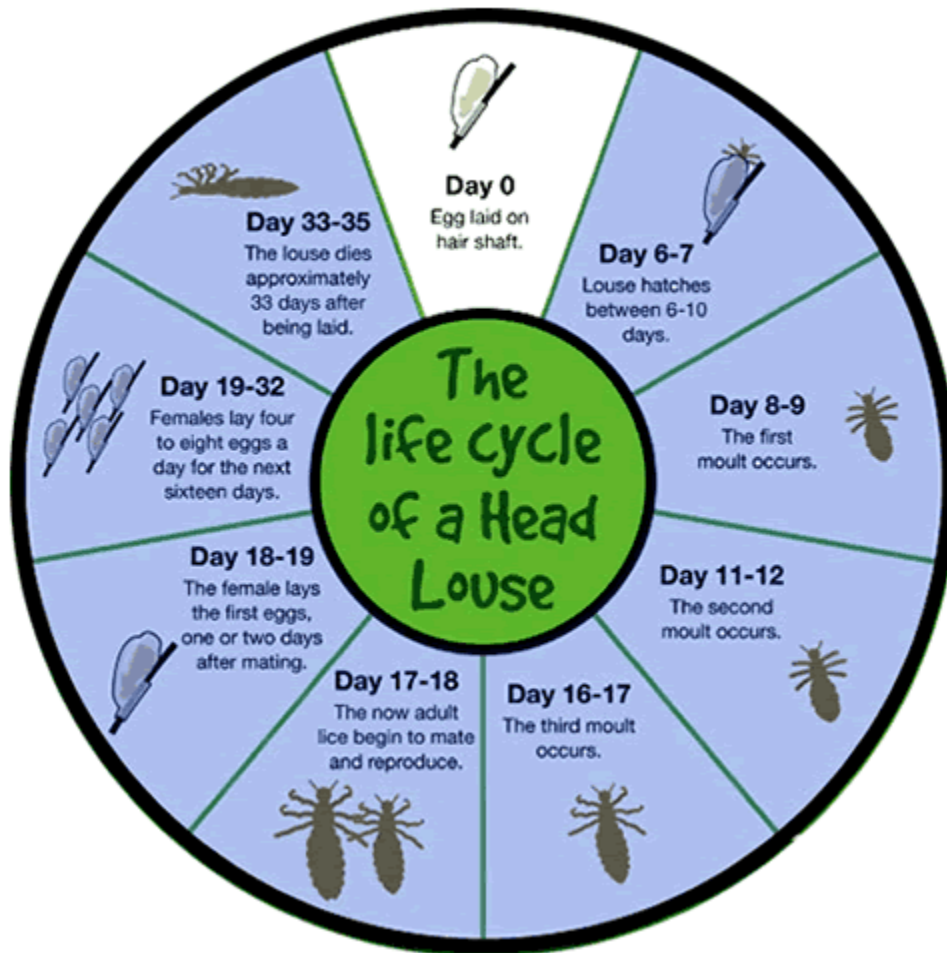


The Life Cycle of Lice



Note the 6-10 days for the nit to hatch and another 7-10 days for it to become a mature adult and can start laying it's own eggs. **This is why it is important for parents to check daily for 3 weeks after treatment and continue nit removal to stop the cycle.** Treatments do not generally kill the nits so they hatch, grow, mature to adults and lay eggs and the cycle continues.
